To bring together young engineers and researchers from both the industry and academia to meet and exchange ideas related to the study and practice of earthquake engineering and civil engineering dynamics.

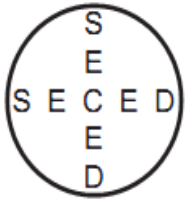
